CODE OF CONDUCT

Cricket Cyclones Code of Conduct is the team's expectations of how everyone involved in summer swim league will behave. Our code of conduct includes being a good team mate, a good host to visiting teams, and a good visitor to other pools. Each swimmer, coach and parent is part of the team.

Be a good team mate!

- Cheer on and encourage everyone at the meets and at practices.
- Never tease, taunt, or boo teammates OR swimmers we are competing against.
- Your team mates are counting on you to do your best. Working hard inspires people around you!

Pay attention to all adults and coaches.

- Listen closely and follow directions from coaches and adults.
- Respect your coaches by learning from them and always working hard.

Use respectful words and voices during practices and meets.

- No screaming is allowed in the bullpen or during staging.
- No cursing is allowed at any time.

Follow rules of our pool and pools we are visiting.

- Always clean up after yourself at the pool - throw trash away promptly.
- Absolutely no alcohol, tobacco or drugs.
- Sanitation is important at a pool. Use sanitary practices in the bathrooms. No spitting.
- Stay out of areas where swimmers aren't allowed and back from the pool when not swimming.
- Stay out of the bullpen and staging areas when you're not swimming. .

Rules & Consequences

Swimmers are expected to follow all Pool Rules and the Cricket Cyclones Code of Conduct. Coaches and adult volunteers will remind swimmers of team rules at practices and meets. For most infractions, coaches will use their discretion and work with parents to help swimmers adhere to rules and code of conduct. Potential consequences include sitting out during practice and being "benched" during a meet.

However, **Disrespectfulness, profanity, inappropriate behavior, or unsportsmanlike conduct will be handled in the following manner:**

1st offense - Parent notification, Discipline at Coaches discretion

2nd Offense - Parent meeting, "benched" from a meet, potential dismissal from team.

3rd Offense - Dismissal from team

In the event of extenuating circumstances, team representatives will make any final decisions.
